



SCHOOL TRAINING FOR LUNCH STAFF

1. USE OF THE MACHINE

- How to use the buttons
 - ◆ Button #1 is for Auger (spiral). This will always be on whenever there is product in the machine. If it is off, then machines will not freeze or refrigerate.
 - ◆ Button #2 should be on during the day in order for the machine to freeze the product. Switch off at night.
 - ◆ Button #3 is for use in night mode (refrigeration). You switch this on and off opposite of Button #2.

2. HOW TO MIX PRODUCT

- Slush product is mixed 5 + 1 ration. Empty contents of 1 (1/2 gallon) bottle of slush syrup into the mixing container, then fill all the way to the top with water.

3. HOW TO CLEAN THE MACHINE

- Clean the machine once per week.
- Disassemble spigot assembly
- Disassemble each bowl head:
 - Remove top
 - Remove bowl
 - Remove auger/spiral
 - Remove suction cup, seal and bowl gasket
- Clean all parts in sink (warm water and soap)
- Clean body of machine (cylinders, white base plates, etc.)
- Reassemble each head (bowl gaskets, auger/spiral) with LUBED suction cups, hopper
- Reassemble spigot assembly (with lubed piston)

- Make sure bowls are “**clicked in**” before filling

4. AM & PM PROCEDURES

Our goal is to make this process as easy and possible for our lunch staff. The following procedures will insure fewer interruptions during lunch as well as efficiently keeping up with demand.

- PM (approximately 10–15 minutes): Fill the machine with product. Fill mixing containers with back up product and store in refrigerator. Switch machine to night mode (refrigeration).
- AM (approximately 10–15 minutes):
 1. Between 6 and 7 AM, when someone arrives to the cafeteria, please turn machine on to freeze mode.
 2. After one hour, empty frozen product out of the machine, cover and store in the **refrigerator**. Refill the machine with the product in the mixing containers from the refrigerator.
 3. You can do this process as many times as necessary to insure that you have enough product ready at all times.
 4. Refill the machine with the **frozen** product from the refrigerator as needed between lunch periods.

*Please do **not** store the product in the freezer, as it will freeze solid and not be ready for use.
